### Club Championships – 3<sup>rd</sup> Round

The final round of the club championships and the JK Monaghan honour board event took place in perfect conditions on Sunday. Also there was a daily competition.

In A grade Scott Brady held on to take the trophy home again with good competition from Tom Grigg. They had a good tussle over the 3 weeks with Scott winning with an overall stroke score of 253, 3 strokes in front of Tom who finished on 256.

It was also a good competition in B grade over the 3 weeks between Ryan Monaghan and Ricky Boyd. So close that after 3 rounds, 54 holes, they couldn't be separated with it ending in a tie with both finishing on 288. They decided not to go to play off holes and will share the B grade club championship title.

In C grade Todd Barker led all the way and despite a 10 stroke lead after round 1 being reduced to 4 strokes by Nick Vine in the second round, Todd went on beat Nick by 4 strokes in the final round to win by 7 strokes overall. Todd finished with a score of 302 while Nick finished with 309.

In the JK Monaghan it was a very proud Todd Barker who took out the win in the event named after his Grandfather. Todd finished with a score of 223, 5 strokes ahead of next best Ryan Monaghan and Nick Vine.

In Sunday's day competitions A grade was won by Scott Brady with a score of 82-8-74, runners up was Rodney Poole with a score of 94-18-76. In B grade Dom Leach was the winner with a score of 107-36-71, runners up was Percy Burns with a score of 110-36-74. There was 1 nearest the pin winner, and that was Ryan Monaghan on 14.

This weekend it is tournament weekend, Friday it is the men's and ladies 4bbb competition, any combination. This is a 10.30 assembly with a 11am start. Then Sunday it's a men's 27 holes and ladies 18 holes single stroke competition. Men's Assembly is 9 am and Ladies is 11.30am.
