Club Championships – 3rd Round

Sunday, 30th June 2024

A cool overcast Sunday greeted golfers for the final round of the club championships, and the single stroke day competition.

The day was set up for some interesting golf in all 3 grades of the club championships and the JK Monaghan handicap event. In A grade 2 strokes separated Tom Grigg and Scott Brady after the first 2 rounds with Tom leading. Scott who has 7 A grade club championships to his name was unable to make it number 8 with Tom continuing with his consistent season shooting an 82 to give him his first A grade championship with an overall score of 247 across the 3 rounds. Scott shot an 89 to give him an overall score of 256 to be runners up.

In B grade 2 shots separated last years joint winners Ryan Monaghan and Ricky Boyd, with Nick Vine just 1 shot further back. Ryan and Ricky both had very good rounds with Ryan shooting 89 and Rick 90 with Nick falling off the pace with a 101. So this gave Ryan the B grade championships, his second in a row, by 3 shots ahead of Rick. Ryan's final score was 283, and Rick finished with 286.

In C grade Gil Grace went into the final round with 2 stroke lead over Trent Crook with Dom Leach a further 5 strokes back. Unfortunately Trent was unable to play today so this left Gil and Dom to battle it out. Gil played another solid round scoring a neat 100, unfortunately Dom couldn't get his game going shooting a 110, so this meant Gil Grace took home his first C grade club championship with a final score of 305, Dom Leach was runners up with 321.

It was a tight finish in the JK Monaghan event with Ricky Boyd coming home the winner with a final handicapped score of 222, one stroke ahead of Tom Grigg and Ryan Monaghan who both finished with 223.

In the day competition it was Ricky Boyd who took home the win in A grade with a score of 90-22-68, runners up was Ryan Monaghan with 89-20-69. In the B grade competition Gil Grace got the win there with his score of 100-27-73, runners up was Paul Dean with 105-28-77.

Nearest the pins were Nick Vine on 2 and 14, and Paul Dean on 16.

So that completes the 3 weeks of club championships, congratulations to our winners. This weekend it is tournament weekend, Friday it is 4bbb competition combined with a single stroke competition, so treat yourself to a day off work and organise yourself a

partner and get along to that. Then on Sunday there will be a Ambrose competition in teams of 3 or 4. So get yourself a group for that. Assembly for both days is 10.30 for a 11.00 am hit off.
